Ref: Review – National Airports Safeguarding Framework Implementation

Thank you for the opportunity to provide feedback on the National Airports Safeguarding Framework (NASF) Implementation.

Sydney Metro Airports (Bankstown and Camden Airports) supports the implementation of the NASF process. It provides a wide reaching and in-depth guidance in an area that has previously been either hard to understand, misunderstood or open to interpretation.

Concern does exist in the area of how this NASF guidance is implemented for off airport activities. A connection needs to be established to ensure that Councils that border Federally leased airports, are triggered to also ensure all the NASF guidelines are followed. This trigger could be established by ensuring that the NASF guidelines are stipulated in State and Local Government documents such as Development Control Plans or Local Environment Plans.
