There were 42 passengers and 5 crew on board. A dispensation was granted for take-off no later than 02:00am local time. This was extended to 02:45am local time. This was further extended to 03:05am local time. The aircraft departed at 02:56am local time.

A dispensation was approved to land no later than 11:30pm. There were 88 passengers and six crew on board. The aircraft landed at 11:26pm.
