## Moorebank Intermodal Terminal

The Australian Government has committed to facilitate the development of an Intermodal Terminal on the School of Military Engineering site at Moorebank. The Moorebank intermodal terminal is a one-off opportunity for NSW. As you are aware, there is no other comparable site in Sydney of similar size and length, which is close to major markets (freight, industrial and population), sufficient distance from Port Botany and accessible to road and rail infrastructure (including the Southern Sydney Freight Line and the M5 and M7 Motorways).

The Government has confirmed that it will be relocating the military units currently located on the Moorebank School of Military Engineering site to Holsworthy Barracks by the end of 2014, which will enable construction of the terminal to be operational in 2017.

I look forward to working with you on these important projects for NSW and the nation and on the development of arrangements for the next phase of the Nation Building Program commencing, from 2014-15.
