




Planning projects:

5. On 15 March 2012, you announced \$2 million for planning for the PortLink Inland Preight Corridor Plan (fully Australian Government funded). On 19 March 2012, you announced \$1 million for planning for the Albany Ring Road Stages 2 and 3 (funded on a 50:50 basis). The draft response to Mr Buswell incorporates the reallocation of funds to these projects.
