How to Complete this Form

Vehicle Details

It is important that these details are correct. If incorrect vehicle details are discovered during a vehicle inspection then you will be asked to correct the import and plate application before the vehicle is approved. If the details are incorrect on the approval then your plate details will also be incorrect and you may not be able to register the vehicle until you arrange for a new plate approval to be issued.

You must provide the vehicle identification number that was issued by the original manufacturer. Make/model details are self explanatory and some models also have a model code which Identifies a particular year range in a model. The vehicle category must be the category associated with the SEVS eligibility number.

The vehicle must be SEVS eligible and you must provide a SEVS Entry Number. This number can be obtained from the RAWS web site. If there is no applicable SEVS Entry Number, then you must apply for a SEVS eligibility decision before this application can be made.

If the vehicle's make and model is already on your RAWS Schedule, the applicable RAWS Schedule Number must be provided, otherwise this vehicle will be considered a sample vehicle.

Application Purpose

This application can be used in several different ways.

If this is an application to import an unrestricted L group vehicle (motorcycle), the vehicle details must exactly match the details in the unrestricted motorcycle register. The corresponding ruling number must be recorded under the SEVS entry number. In the instance where the vehicle is not listed on the unrestricted motorcycle register a request to add a vehicle can be made as per the instruction on the unrestricted motorcycle register website. http://raws.infrustructure.gov.au/motorcycles/index.htm

- 1. To apply to import a first vehicle during a RAW application or to import the first vehicle of a type not on the company's schedule of approved vehicles.
- 2. To apply to plate a vehicle. If you wish to just plate a vehicle we will require the import approval number for the vehicle.
- 3. To apply to import and plate a vehicle.

How to Submit this Form

Submitting the Form Electronically

Ensure you are connected to the Internet. Click on the 'Submit' button to submit the form. If you have not satisfied the form validation then a message will appear and you will not be able to submit the form until all errors have been rectified. Fix any errors, save the form and press the 'Submit' button again. A message should display confirming the form has been submitted successfully.

IMPORT APPROVAL ISSUED UNDER REGULATION 15 - REGISTERED AUTOMOTIVE WORKSHOP

I approve the importation of the vehicle described in the Schedule below under regulation 15 of the Motor Vehicle Standards Regulations and section 20(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicle Standards Act 1989 (the Act) on the condition that:

- 1. Unless otherwise authorised by the Administrator, a Used Import Plate must be affixed to the vehicle within 12 months of the date of this approval;
- 2. If condition 1 is not met the vehicle must be exported or destroyed within 30 days of the expiry of the 12 months in condition (1); and
- 3. The holder of this approval shall advise the Administrator in writing within 2 business days of the vehicle being exported or destroyed

and on the basis that I am satisfied that:

- i. the applicant is a registered automotive workshop; and
- ii. the vehicle was manufactured on or after 1 January 1989; and
- iii. the make and model of the vehicle is included in the schedule of approved vehicles for the applicant; and
- iv. the application to import was accompanied by an application for approval to place a used import plate on the vehicle; and
- v. for a vehicle other than a two-wheeled or three-wheeled vehicle approval has not been granted to the applicant to import more than a total of 130 vehicles in the vehicle category to which the vehicle belongs in the period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the application; and
- vi. for a restricted volume two-wheeled or three-wheeled vehicle—approval has not been granted to the applicant to import more than a total of 130 vehicles in the vehicle category to which the vehicle belongs in the period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the application.

To contravene any of the above conditions could be an offence under subsection 20(3)(b) of the Act that may attract a penalty not exceeding 60 penalty units. To sell the vehicle or use it in transport in Australia before a Used Import Plate is affixed could be an offence under section 16 the Act that may attract a penalty not exceeding 120 penalty units.

Approval is given, under section 17A of the Act, for you to take delivery of the vehicle.

For the purpose of this approval "Used Import Plate" means a Used Import Plate approved by the Minister pursuant to section 13D of the Act.



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How to Complete this Form

The Vehicle Inspection Certificate (VIC) is the report used by the Minister or his delegate (the Administrator of Vehicle Standards) to determine if a used imported vehicle complies with the guidelines for approval to place a used import plate and therefore if it is appropriate to approve the placement of that plate. By providing your name as Vehicle Inspection Certificate Signatory for your workshop you are assuring the Minister that the vehicle described in this certificate meets all of the requirements set out in the **Motor Vehicle Standards (Approval to Place Used Import Plates) Guidelines 2006 (No. 1).** You are also stating that the evidence referenced in this certificate, demonstrates compliance and that your workshop currently holds this evidence and will retain it for at least 10 years after the used import plate is fitted.

Submission of this Certificate indicates that the vehicle is complete and ready to be fitted with a Used Import Plate.

Application Reference

This section requires the RAW ID which is a 5 digit number.

The Document Reference must be provided and must be no longer than 12 characters. It is required that each RAW has a document tracking system that ensures the same document reference cannot be used twice. Forms with a Document Reference that is identical to one on a previously submitted form will be rejected.

Replacement Form

In the event that you need to correct something on this form before you are issued with a Used Import Plate approval, you can submit a replacement form with the details corrected. The replaced form Document Reference No. field must contain the exact Document Reference of the Certificate you wish to replace. We will withdraw the original form and process the replacement.

Vehicle Details

These fields should accurately describe the vehicle, where the fields are the same, they must match the information on the import approval. If it is determined that this does not match the vehicle, ie an incorrect VIN, you must contact the RAWS team to have your import approval reissued.

Where you are importing a SEVS eligible vehicle, the vehicle details must exactly match the details in the SEVS Register. The Minister will not approve the placement of a Used Import Plate where the vehicle is not listed on the Register. If the vehicle is not one of the variants listed under the SEVS ruling you should contact the RAWS team and find out if you can have the SEVS ruling amended before you submit your Vehicle Inspection Certificate.

Where you are importing an unrestricted L group vehicle (Motor cycle), the vehicle details must exactly match the details in the unrestricted motorcycle register. The corresponding ruling number must be recorded under the SEVS entry number. In the instance where the vehicle is not listed on the unrestricted motorcycle register a request to add a vehicle can be made as per the instruction on the unrestricted motorcycle register website. http://raws.infrustructure.gov.au/motorcycles/index.htm

If your vehicle is not on your Schedule of Approved Vehicles, you must leave the RAWS Schedule Number blank, otherwise ensure that you include the correct schedule number or the form may be rejected.



VIN Location, Used Import Plate Location and Engine Number Location

On the VIC, select the chart that most accurately describes the location of the plate or number, write that number in the first box, then select the letter that describes the row or column closest to the plate or number, then select the number that describes the other axes.

Variant Details

Where the SEVS ruling indicates that only some variants are eligible, the Variant name must match one of those variants, this will be checked by the RAWS team and non SEVS eligible vehicles will be refused a used import plate.

The form will guide you in the entry of the other variant details, where information is not required for a particular vehicle category, the field heading will be replaced with "Not Required"

Cells marked with a bell, indicates that required information is not provided, or that the value entered appears to be out of range. If you are happy that the value is correct, you may submit the form with the bell still present.

Cells marked with a cross, indicate that a value entered is out of range and is definitely incorrect. Forms received with crosses will most likely be rejected. If you feel that the cross is incorrect, you may submit the form with a note explaining why you think it should be accepted. You can place a note by clicking on "edit" then "note" in the menu.

Evidence Details

New checks have been added to the evidence section that raise a cross if the ADR number and evidence type are not one of the acceptable combinations from the **Motor Vehicle Standards** (Approval to Place Used Import Plates) Guidelines 2006 (No. 1).

Saving the Form

The Form must be saved before you submit it to the RAWS Team. Be aware that long filenames and those with non text characters can cause problems with submission, so please keep the filenames short and simple. The button on page 11 is used to save the form.

Submitting the Form

Plate Approval Document

I grant the Registered Automotive Workshop (RAW) named above approval to place a Used Import Plate on the vehicle described in the Schedule below (the vehicle) under subsection 13D(1) of the *Motor Vehicle Standards Act 1989* (the Act) on the basis that I am satisfied that the Vehicle Inspection Certificate provided for the vehicle satisfies the requirements of Motor Vehicle Standards (Approval to Place Used Import Plates) Guidelines 2006 made pursuant to subsection 13D(3) of the Act.

The conditions of this approval, made pursuant to subsection 13D(5), are that:

- 1. A Used Import Plate must not be placed on any vehicle other than the vehicle described on the plate.
- 2. A Used Import Plate must not be placed on any vehicle for which there is no Approval to Place a Used Import Plate.
- 3. A Used Import Plate must not be placed on the vehicle described in this approval if the vehicle has ever suffered crash damage or corrosion that is likely to affect the structural integrity of the vehicle based on the criteria set out in sub-clause 6(3) of the Motor Vehicle Standards (Procedures for Inspecting and Testing Used Imported Vehicles) Determination 2002.
- 4. A Used Import Plate must not be placed on the vehicle described in this approval if the vehicle does not comply with the requirements of the Motor Vehicle Standards (Approval to Place Used Import Plates) Guidelines 2006 up to and including amendment 1.
- 5. A Used Import Plate must not be placed on the vehicle described in the approval if the approval holder does not hold evidence demonstrating that the vehicle complies with the requirements of the Motor Vehicle Standards (Approval to Place Used Import Plates) Guidelines 2006 up to and including amendment 1.
- 6. A Used Import Plate may only be placed on the vehicle described in this approval if all of the assembly operations required to ensure that the vehicle complies with the Motor Vehicle Standards (Approval to Place Used Import Plates) Guidelines 2006 up to and including amendment 1 were conducted at the workshop address specified in this approval (excepting those items listed in regulation 57 (m).
- A Used Import Plate may only be placed on the vehicle described in this approval holder.
- 8. The approval holder must not knowingly allow the vehicle described in the approval to be modified such that it does not comply with the evidence referred to the Vehicle Inspection Certificate before the vehicle is supplied to the market.

To contravene any of the conditions could be an offence under subsection 13D(6) of the Act that may attract a penalty not exceeding 60 penalty units.

For the purpose of this approval "Used Import Plate" means a Used Import Plate approved by the Minister pursuant to section 13D of the Act.

An application may be made to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal for a review of this decision or you may request, under section 28 of the *Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1975*, reasons for my decision. Any applications or requests should be made within 28 days of receipt of this notice.

This approval is a matter of public record.
