Further to our discussion yesterday, we are seeking the following information in regard to the possibility of reducing flights again because of medical advice on the mainland. We seek this information in order to provide advice to the Minister.

Current arrangements

- For the period 21 August onwards, if flights were reduced back to 1 flight per week from Brisbane and 1 flight per week from Sydney, what would be the impact on Air New Zealand operations, both logistically and monetary (we accept that this may be unrealistic as it is not easy to change schedules at such short notice);
- For the period 1 September onwards, if flights were reduced back to 1 flight per week from Brisbane and 1
 flight per week from Sydney, what would be the impact on Air New Zealand operations, both logistically and
 monetary;
- For the period 1 October onwards, if flights were reduced back to 1 flight per week from Brisbane and 1 flight per week from Sydney, what would be the impact on Air New Zealand operations, both logistically and monetary.

Good to talk this morning and thanks for keeping me updated. My thoughts are as follows and as discussed:

- We should be prudent with spending taxpayers money.
- These estimates are estimates and don't reflect our objective to rebuild visitors numbers and Norfolk Island as a travel destination.
- To do this we need scheduled flights it is a chicken and egg scenario. Without flights we have no capacity to promote the destination. We need 8/10 weeks lead time to have a chance of securing a booking.
- October still appears to be looking positive for bookings.

NB: the changing situation in respect of CV-19 and associated travel restrictions.

With the above in mind my request is to consider the following:

- Resume the second Brisbane flight on Tuesday the 28th of September
- Resume the second Sydney (Friday) flight on the 23rd of October (in-line with Air NZ request to maintain this schedule beyond October)
- This gives us two flights ex Sydney and two flights ex Brisbane post October and an incentive for industry and NIRC to market the destination.

With regard to the intersection with freight services as discussed:

- There would appear to be no capacity issues with sea freight for the next 4/5 months, with an additional sailing of the Southern Tiare and three Boral barges approved by Parks and Bio-Security to augment freight capacity on the Southern Tiare.
- NIRC (or Boral) needs to be doing more to promote the availability of the additional capacity on these three barge services to the broader market place.
- Sea freight should be the first option for importers on Norfolk Island as it is run by the private sector.
- Currently there is an underwritten weekly TOLL air freight service out of Brisbane.
- It would be a great concern if the underwritten passenger services were not carrying the maximum capacity of freight they are able to, when at the same time we are subsidising a dedicated weekly freight service. Acknowledging that the configuration of the passenger plane and limitations for carrying refrigerated cargo.
- All efforts should be made to make sure that as much freight as possible is being carried on the passenger flights, this includes Australia Post using these regular services as well. Does Burnt Pine have any incentive to see this happen?
- The objective should be to reduce the requirement for a weekly subsidised air freight service to either a fortnightly or three weekly service. Reducing the cost to tax-payers subsidising these services.

I hope this is of assistance and I am happy to discuss further as required.

Gave you a call to discuss the rescheduling of Air NZ flights and the brief we will be sending to the Assistant Minister.

In light of the new mainland border closures, we have had to revisit the scheduling of additional flights as per your request of 22 June 2020.

Our current exposure for Air NZ flights s47C If we maintain the current schedule with flights increasing from August/September and again in October/November as requested this exposure s47C

By adjusting the schedule now, back to one flight per week per destination we will be able to mitigate s47C

Air New Zealand have indicated that there will be no extra cost to the Government by adjusting the schedule again.

We have reviewed the passenger numbers from Sydney and Brisbane and there is very limited demand outside of essential workers and residents returning. Forward bookings from Sydney are very poor and Brisbane is only marginally better.

We intend to brief the Assistant Minister that we will be minimising the flight schedule back to one flight per week in order to mitigate the cost to the Australian Government.



To inform her consideration, could we please get some more information about costs that would be incurred by what Eric is proposing:

- 3 flights per week (2 from Brisbane, 1 from Sydney)

(i.e. the difference in cost of underwriting 2 vs 3 flights per week)

I understand having only one flight per week may mean people visiting Norfolk would need to stay on-Island for the full week, and not be able to book shorter visits. Not sure if consideration has been given to if this would act as a deterrent to people visiting Norfolk, and potentially cost us more in the end.

Eric also mentioned an issue of a pattern in which people book services and giving industry a chance to try and sell it.

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

Please find below the proposed response to a media enquiry received from the Norfolk Islander asking about several claims heard on Island that Air New Zealand is breaking their contract and is pulling out of Norfolk. S47F has asked if it's true and for our response. Though it's for the Islander, I would like to get this cleared and respond to the Islander ASAP today, rather than their usual Thursday deadline, to prevent the rumours getting more legs.

PROPOSED RESPONSE:

Air New Zealand is not ceasing passenger and freight flights to Norfolk Island.

Air New Zealand, with Australian Government support, is committed to delivering their critical passenger and freight services to Norfolk Island.

Flight schedule arrangements will vary depending on demand and COVID 19-related travel restrictions. Changes to flight schedules do not mean that Air New Zealand is no longer going to fly to Norfolk Island.
