As mentioned, we have prepared mapping instructions for remaining new projects in Vic that will require maps to support Budget announcements. Consistent with the other recent requests grateful for your review of the mapping instructions before these go to the GIS team Wednesday morning.

Mapping Instructions:

1. Check that the map subtitle appropriately reflects the project and confirm that the subtitle is accurate.
2. Check that the instruction column correctly reflects the location details of the project.
3. Review if there is something in the project vicinity that should be captured in the map.
4. Ensure that any changes that are made to the attached are done so in track changes.
5. **Return appropriately cleared mapping instructions to IIDBudget@infrastructure.gov.au**
