



Extension of Declaration of State of Emergency

Cocos (Keeling) Islands Emergency Management Ordinance 2012

I, Aaron O'Neill, Deputy Administrator of the Territory of Cocos (Keeling) Islands, under section 18 of the *Cocos (Keeling) Islands Emergency Management Ordinance 2012* (the Ordinance),

Being **SATISFIED** that an emergency, namely the COVID-19 pandemic, is occurring or imminent and extraordinary measures are required to prevent or minimise the loss of life of, illness of, or injury to, humans in the Territory of Cocos (Keeling) Islands,

EXTEND the declaration of a state of emergency that commenced at 12:30 pm on Friday 17 April 2020.

This extension commences at 12:30 pm on Wednesday 31 March 2021, and has effect for 72 hours.

As a result of this extension, the state of emergency in the Territory continues to exist until 12:30 pm on Saturday 3 April 2021.
