Topic	Motorcycle Learner Rider Training Course and Motorcycle Provisional Rider Licence Assessment - Monday 6 June 2011

The Jervis Bay Territory Administration (Motor Vehicle Registry) is arranging the delivery of a *Stay Upright* training course for Motorcycle Learner Riders and Motorcycle Provisional Rider Assessments to be held on Monday 6 June at the Jervis Bay Range Facility (Airfield).

Motorcycle Learner Rider Training Course (*Stay Upright*) – cost \$241 per person

The *Stay Upright* course is available to Jervis Bay Territory residents aged at least 16 years 9 months and who hold an ACT Driver Licence or Learner Car Licence. *Stay Upright* will be conducted between 8 am and 4:30pm.

When you successfully complete the *Stay Upright* course you may then attend the Jervis Bay Territory Motor Vehicle Registry to have your ACT Driver Licence endorsed with the Motorcycle Learner Rider class.

Motorcycle Provisional Rider Licence Assessment – cost \$46 per person per person


The Motorcycle Provisional Licence Assessment is available to Jervis Bay Territory residents who have attained an age of at least 17 years and have held an ACT Learner Rider class on their licence for at least three months. Assessments are scheduled to commence at 4:30pm immediately following the *Stay Upright* course.

When you successfully complete the Provisional Licence Assessment you may then attend the Jervis Bay Territory Motor Vehicle Registry to have your ACT Driver Licence endorsed with the Motorcycle Provisional Rider class.

There are a limited number of places available for each activity. Bookings accompanied by the full course/licence assessment fee will be accepted, on a 'first come, first served' basis, at the Administration Office.
