Topic	Proposed Fees for Electricity 2011		
Relevance	Jervis Bay Territory residents and organisations		

The Jervis Bay Territory Administration (the Administration) is proposing to increase electricity fees effective 1 July 2011 and you will see the new fees on your first bill in the new financial year.

In proposing the new fees, the Administration has taken into account a number of factors including the comparable retail prices in the nearby Shoalhaven region and the costs to the Administration in purchasing electricity, engaging contractors to operate the distribution network and retailing electricity within the Territory. Examples of the new fee structure are:

2. First 1167 kWh for a 60-day period (ea kWh)	0.195250	0.208230	6.65
3. For balance of electricity supply (ea kWh)	0.212850	0.230560	8.32

General Supply	2009 (incl GST)	2011 (incl GST)	% Variance
1. System Access (ea day)	0.594000	0.704000	18.52
2. First 3506 kWh for a 60-day period (ea kWh)	0.181500	0.192280	5.94
3. For balance of electricity supply (ea kWh)	0.195030	0.209550	7.45
