The ACT Government has released the *Domestic Animals (Fees) Determination 2011 (No 1)* which sets the fees and charges applicable to domestic animal transactions within the Jervis Bay Territory. The new determination will take effect from 1 July 2011.

A brief summary of the most common charges is included below:

Lifetime registration of a dog	\$ 44.35
Lifetime registration of a dog where keeper is a pension/benefit recipient	\$ 16.55
Issue of a permit to keep any cat or dog that has not been desexed	\$ 333.85
Issue of a permit to keep any cat or dog that has not been desexed where keeper is a pension/benefit recipient	\$ 66.55
Surrendering of dog ownership	\$ 46.50
