Interruption to Water Supply – parts of Jervis Bay Village

The Jervis Bay Territory Administration's water supply maintenance contractors advise that there is a requirement to carry out repairs to part of the Jervis Bay Village water reticulation system. To carry out these repairs it is necessary to interrupt the water supply.

Considering the urgency of the repair work, and timings that would cause the least disruption to residents and businesses, it has been determined that the water supply will be interrupted on

Saturday, 27 August 2011 between 1 pm and 4 pm

After the water supply is restored residents may notice a milky appearance to the water and possible sputtering of taps over subsequent days. This is caused by air trapped in the mains and has no affect on water quality. The milky appearance will dissipate rapidly if water is left in an open top jug on the bench or in the fridge.
