The next visit of the Mobile Library Service to Jervis Bay Territory is scheduled for **Thursday 22 March 2012.**

The Mobile Library will then operate each Thursday fortnight between 11:50 am and 12:50 pm at the Jervis Bay School (during school terms) and Jervis Bay Village Community Health Centre (outside school terms). Please see the schedule for the rest of 2012 overleaf.

Joining the Library is free on presentation of personal identification showing a current local address or Navy personnel card.

Library members enjoy a range of benefits including free borrowing of any items in the lending collections, a reservation service for items currently on loan and access to inter-library loans.

In addition to these benefits members can also borrow from any of the libraries within the local government areas of Shoalhaven City (libraries located in Sanctuary Point, Nowra, Milton and Ulladulla), Eurobodalla and Kiama.
