Topic: Proposed 2014 Fees for Electricity

The Commonwealth facilitates the provision of electricity supply in the Jervis Bay Territory (JBT) through the Jervis Bay Territory Administration (Administration). The Commonwealth proposes to increase electricity fees effective from 1 July 2014 through the Electricity Supply Fees Determination 2014 (Jervis Bay Territory) (2014 Determination).

In developing the new fees, a number of factors have been considered including the retail pricing of electricity in the nearby Shoalhaven region and the costs of providing electricity within the JBT.

All JBT electricity fees are GST inclusive.
