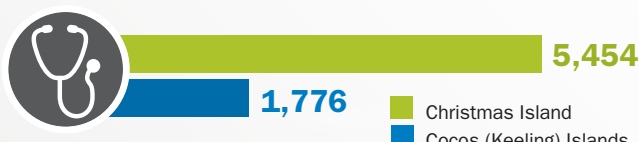

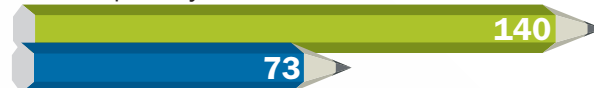

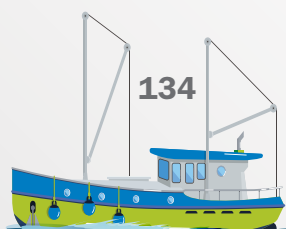

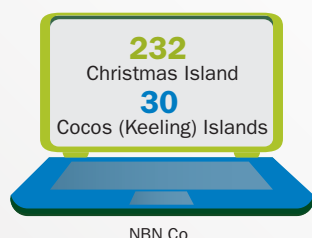

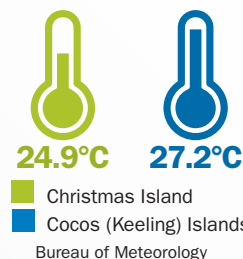

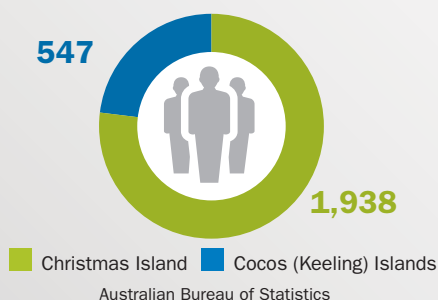
HIGHER EDUCATION STUDENTS (2018)



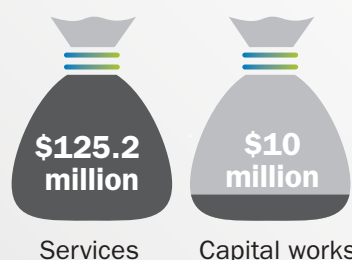
WEATHER MEDIAN TEMPERATURE



POPULATION AT 31 DECEMBER 2018



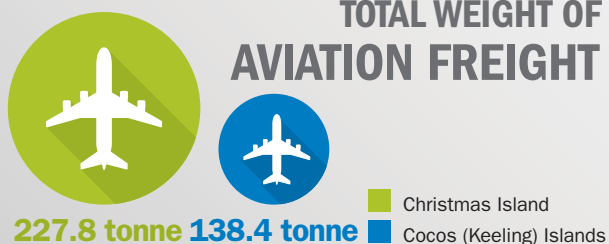
AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT BUDGET FOR THE INDIAN OCEAN TERRITORIES
