### General

- Change is too slow and not keeping up to date with current codes/standards.
- Implementation appears behind the programs set.

### Specific comments

#### Section A p4

Reference to AS1428.2 is not appropriate as it is not consistent with the Premises Standard and Current Standards (AS1428.1).

#### Section C p 6

- Question 1 dot point 4      To meet AS1428.1 is the greatest need.
- Question 3 first part      DSAPT do not meet accessibility requirements and confusion exist as they refer to AS1428.2.
- Question 3 second part      TGSI to an isolated country school bus stop appears of little value but is required. Some review is suggested.
