VIN	Vehicle Identification Number	Required on vehicle and Identification Plates (ADR 61/02) / (Circular 0-3-2). Required to be supplied to NEVDIS (Circular 0-3-9 Attachment 2).	Required for all RAV records.  Required as the primary means of uniquely identify a vehicle.
Approval Number	The Type Approval Number for vehicles supplied under the type approval pathway (or Concessional RAV entry approval).  The Model report approval number will also be applicable for Concessional RAV entry vehicles subject to clause 37 of the draft Road Vehicle Standards Rules (the Rules) – vehicles to be modified by the holder of a RAW approval	Required on Identification Plate (Circular 0-3-2). Vehicle Category Code	The Vehicle Category Code (VCC) is as defined in Vehicle Standard (Australian Design Rules – Definitions and Vehicle Categories) 2005 (Note: As a result of testing, the department has expanded the list of VCC to include some sub categories aligning it with vehicle certification). Name of Holder of Approval	The Holder of Approval accepts responsibility for the vehicle's compliance with the Australian Design Rules (ADRs) or relevant standards. Month and Year of Build Date	Date of Build is the Month and Year (MM/YYYY) on which the vehicle was substantially completed. Guidance for substantial completion is:  Motorcycles and Passenger Cars: the calendar month and the year in which the body shell and power train sub-assemblies are conjoined and the vehicle is driven or moved from the production line.  Commercial vehicles and busses: The calendar month and the year in which the cabin and chassis, or body shell, and power train subassemblies are conjoined and the vehicle is driven or moved from the production line. Alternatively, for a cab/chassis vehicle that is manufactured in stages at more than one location and that remains under the control of the original equipment manufacturer, the calendar month and the year in which the body is fitted to the cab/chassis and the vehicle is driven or moved from the production line. Entry Pathway Sub- category	Entry Pathway is the method through which the vehicle was approved to be provided for the first time in Australia. There are two entry pathways – the type approval pathway and the concessional RAV entry pathway.  A sub-category refers to a particular set of circumstances that are relevant to the approval under the relevant entry pathway.	Different Identification plates demonstrate entry pathways (Circular 0-3-2 Attachment 1).
