



CIRCULAR No.24A 3 1

INTERPRETATIONS

Attached are interpretations issued by the Board in respect of Australian Design Rule No. 24A - Tyre Selection (December 1985).

They should be read in conjunction with Circular No.0-11-1.

Interpretation No. 1 (Clauses 24A.2.3.2.to 24A.2.3.7)

Question: Does the statement relating to load rating in clauses 24A.2.3.2 to 24A.2.3.7 require both the load rating in kg and the load rating index?

Answer: Yes. The statement shall be the words within Quotation marks in the above clauses with the appropriate values for load rating inserted in kg and load rating index.

Interpretation No. 2 (Clause 24A.2.3.1)

Question: Is it permissible to indicate vehicle model variants on one tyre placard where the manufacturer specifies different tyres *or* inflation pressures for the variants?

Answer: No. Where the manufacturer specifies or ADR 24A requires different tyres or inflation pressures between vehicle model variants separate tyre placards are required.
