INTERPRETATIONS

Attached is an interpretation issued by the Board in respect of Australian Design Rule No.34 - Child Restraint Anchorages (March 1976).

It should be read in conjunction With Circular No 0-11-1.

Australian Design Rule No. 34 - Child Restraint Anchorages

as endorsed by the Australian Transport Advisory Council – March 1976.

Interpretation No.1 (clause 34.2.4)

Question: How is the location of the child restraint anchorages to be specified?

Answer: By means of photographs, drawings, sketches or descriptions adequate to demonstrate to the owner of the vehicle the position of each anchorage in relation to clearly identifiable vehicle features adjacent to the child restraint anchorage location.
