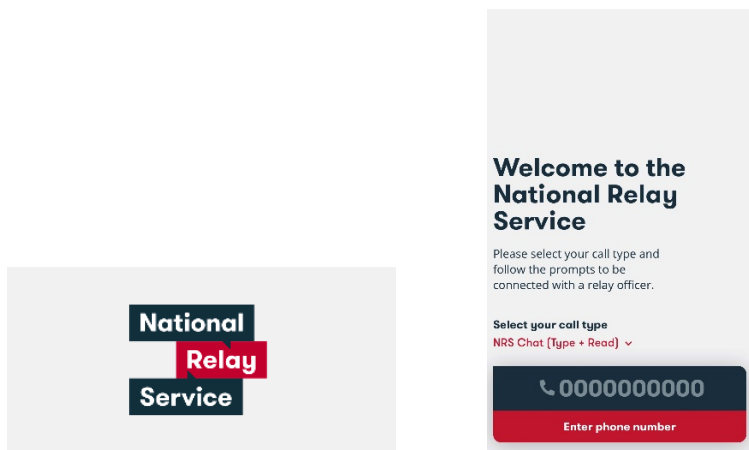
## Fact sheet 3—NRS app

### What equipment is needed?

An Apple or Android smartphone or tablet and an internet connection is needed to download and use the NRS app.

### How much will it cost?

The app is free. Broadband data costs will apply to download the app and make calls. The app is called 'NRS' and is recognisable by the National Relay Service logo below left.



### Things to remember

- The NRS app allows users to access a number of call options, including NRS Chat, Voice Relay, NRS Captions and Video Relay.
- The new app has been redesigned to be more user friendly and accessible and will continue to be further developed with more features and enhancements added based on user feedback.
