#### **Region Background & Context**

- The Yorke and Mid North region covers an area of approximately 34,930 square kilometres with a total population of 76,549 people (ABS 2010), this representing almost a quarter of the regional population of South Australia.
- Around 80 individual communities form the broader Yorke and Mid North region aligning around the geographic sub-regions of the Southern Flinders Ranges, Yorke Peninsula, Clare Valley & Mid North.
- The largest centre in the region is Port Pirie with a population of 13, 206 with the townships of Kadina (4,026), Moonta (3,350), Clare (3,063), and Wallaroo (3,053) forming the next distinctive tier of population concentration in the region.
- Towns such as Peterborough, Balaklava, Crystal Brook, Jamestown, Ardrossan, and Maitland are other recognised service hubs in the region, all with populations of between one and two thousand people.
- Around 30,000 people are located outside of the main service centres, in smaller communities of under one thousand people or rurally based outside of any defined township.
- A major portion of our region includes farming districts, with some significant primary producing areas. Many of the agricultural farming properties are substantial in size and a lack of mobile coverage poses risks to those working on the land and or transporting to major port and storage hubs, particularly when injury occurs.
- Many of the wineries in the Clare Valley do not have mobile coverage which impacts upon their day to day business operations. Both the agricultural and viticulture industries experience delays relating to varying aspects of their operations due to limited or no mobile coverage.
- Our agricultural areas in addition to the Southern Flinders are major fire risk areas and the recent bushfires in Banglor earlier this year burnt 90 per cent of the Wirrabara Forest in the southern Flinders Ranges, just a year after a fire in the Bundaleer Forest wiped out 30 per cent of pine plantations. There were many risks for residents and emergency service workers unable to communicate.

Attached is a list of black spots compiled from extensive consultation within the region residents, business and industry representatives, including professionals that are required to travel throughout the region on a regular basis including health and government workers.

The items highlighted are considered to be some of our major priorities, based on population, transport routes and risk relating to emergency service communication – these are also summarised in attachment 1
