The regulation of online content to protect against cyberbullying, abuse, and child safety is an important matter that I fully stand behind. Many parts of the proposed Online Safety Bill 2020 address such issues and will help achieve this goal, although I find some parts of this bill not fitting to the best interests of many Australians.

I am a sex worker in Melbourne, I produce and upload softcore porn images/ videos to online platforms which is an essential part of my business and livelihood. My business and income have become profoundly reliant on creating such content in a post COVID19 world.

My concern lies in Part 9 of the Online Safety Bill 2020 which seeks to regulate online content including online pornography and gives the E-Safety Commissioner the power to take down online adult content.

As someone who not only creates online adult content but relies on it as sole income, Part 9 threatens my business and therefore livelihood. Not only does Part 9 affect people's businesses, but it also impacts the freedom of expression of consenting adults. I am calling on Part 9 to be removed from the Online Safety Bill 2020 on behalf of myself and the many other individuals in the same position as me.
