We appreciate being invited to comment on the Proposed Extension of Carrier Licence Conditions (Networks supplying Superfast Carriage Services to Residential Customers) Declaration 2014 (**CLC**).

The CLC was originally established as a short-term measure to provide regulatory certainty whilst the Government implemented its proposed changes to Part 7 and 8 of the Telecommunications Act.
