Telecommunications Reform Package

I live in Tynong North Victoria 3813, a borderline rural area with a Telstra fixed copper line ADSL 2 + telephone connection. The cost is approximately \$130 per month.

My unlimited data downloads average 8Mbps and I can make unlimited local, mobile and international calls.

Currently there are no plans to introduce fixed line NBL and the wireless network isn't capable of overcoming trees and geography.

My only NBN option is a switch to satellite.

After searching through all the listed satellite service providers I haven't yet found one that can offer a package to match my existing contact at any price.

The data allowances don't even come close (even assuming I stay up all night using the off-peak component). I would also require the equivalent of my current voice service.

I'm dreading the day when I'm forced to switch to an NBN service where I'd be paying significantly more for considerably less.
