Public Consultation on the draft National Road Safety Strategy 2021-30

Australian Infrastructure and Transport Ministers welcome the opening of consultation on the draft National Road Safety Strategy 2021-30 today.

The draft strategy has been developed by the Commonwealth and state and territory governments, along with the Australian Local Government Association.

The draft strategy sets the direction of Australia's road safety objectives, key priorities for action and road trauma reduction targets for the decade to 2030. This will set Australia on the path to achieve Vision Zero by 2050—zero deaths and serious injuries from road crashes.

Following the consultation period, feedback received will be taken into account in finalising the strategy.
