Hi,

In regards to the control of emissions from motor vehicles.

Requirements for emissions to be reduced.

All vehicles be tested for emissions prior to the vehicles warranty expiring making the manufacturers repair or replace defective components under warranty. This would ensure that manufacturers provide long lasting emission controls eg catalytic converters and sensors.

Ensure that vehicles sold in Australia can endure the poor quality fuel in Australia without increases in emissions over testing done elsewhere where sulphur is limited to 10 PPM.

Ensure that direct injection petrol vehicles do not emit more noxious emissions than Multi-point injected vehicles.

Ensure that the inclusion of ethanol into fuels does not not damage injection systems in the long term, leading to increases in emissions.
